A telephonic meeting of the Arizona Board of Behavioral Health Examiners was called to order on December 3, 2020, at 12:02 p.m. with Ms. Dobratz presiding.

3. Complaints and other disciplinary matters: review, consideration and action.

A. Lorraine Land, LPC-18574

Ms. Zavala summarized the results of the Board's investigation.

The professional appeared telephonically and addressed the Board.

Following review and discussion by members, Ms. Dobratz moved, seconded by Dr. Davis, to open a complaint and find the following violations:

- A.R.S. § 32-3251(16)(I), engaging in any conduct, practice or condition that impairs the ability of the licensee to safely and competently practice the licensee's profession
- A.R.S. § 32-3251(16)(c)(i), making any oral or written misrepresentation of a fact to secure or attempt to secure the issuance or renewal of a license
- A.R.S. § 32-3251(16)(ii), violating any federal or state law, rule or regulation applicable to the practice of behavioral health as it relates to:
 - A.A.C. R4-6-208, Conviction of a Felony or Prior Disciplinary Action
- A.R.S. § 32-3251(16)(II), being the subject of the revocation, suspension, surrender or any other disciplinary sanction of a professional license, certificate or registration or other adverse action related to a professional license, certificate or registration in another jurisdiction or country, including the failure to report the adverse action to the board. The action taken may include refusing, denying, revoking or suspending a license or certificate, the surrendering of a license or certificate, otherwise limiting, restricting or monitoring a licensee or certificate holder or placing

a licensee or certificate holder on probation

The motion passed unanimously.

Following further discussion, Ms. Dobratz moved, seconded by Dr. Davis, to find that there is imminent danger to the health, safety and welfare of the public, and summarily suspend the professional's license pursuant to A.R.S. § 32-3281(C). The motion passed unanimously.
