**SUBSTANTIVE POLICY STATEMENT # 2017-01**

**SUBSTANTIVE POLICY STATEMENT REGARDING SUPERVISION ACQUIRED IN  
ANOTHER STATE BY AN APPLICANT FOR ARIZONA LICENSURE**

This substantive policy statement is advisory only. A substantive policy statement does not include internal procedural documents that only affect the internal procedure of the agency and does not impose additional requirements or penalties on regulated parties or include confidential information or rules made in accordance with the Arizona Administrative Procedure Act. If you believe that this substantive policy statement does impose additional requirements or penalties on regulated parties, you may petition the agency under A.R.S. § 41-1033 for a review of the statement. A.R.S. § 41-1091(B).

Applicants for independent level licensure must demonstrate a minimum of two years of supervised work experience meeting the requirements of A.A.C. R4-6-403, R4-6-503, R4-6-603, R4-6-705, and R4-6-211. Applicants who have acquired supervision outside of Arizona while practicing in another state may submit those hours for purposes of establishing eligibility pursuant to A.A.C. R4-6-211(B).

In its review, the Academic Review Committee shall, among other qualifying factors, determine whether the supervision met the requirements of the state in which it occurred.
