CEASE AND DESIST ORDER

The above-captioned matter came before the Arizona State Board of Behavioral Health Examiners ("Board") on October 14, 2022, for the purposes of determining whether grounds existed to issue a Cease and Desist Order to Dondra Lafrance Campbell ("Respondent"). Respondent was properly noticed of the Board's review of this issue, but did not appear.

FACTS REVIEWED

- 1. Respondent has never been certified/licensed by the Board.
- 2. On 09/02/22, a complaint was submitted against Respondent alleging the following:
 - a. On 08/10/22, Respondent submitted a counseling referral for a client to their clinic, stating the client was one of his students.
 - b. At the bottom of the referral, Respondent identified himself as "MC, LPC."
 - c. There is no public record showing Respondent is an LPC and there is concern he is misrepresenting himself.
 - 3. Due to Respondent not being licensed, no complaint was opened.
- 4. On 09/16/22, Respondent was notified via mail of the allegations and a response to questions from Board staff was requested, but to date, no response has been received.
- 5. On 09/19/22, a social worker with Respondent's employer ("School") reached out to Board staff with concerns regarding Respondent.

- 6. It is represented that Respondent was providing psychotherapy services to the students at School.
- 7. The Executive Director ("Director") of School provided a copy of Respondent's license for review, which indicated the following:
 - a. "Be It Known That [Respondent] Having exhibited to the [Board]'s satisfactory evidence of having met requirements to practice as prescribed by law, is hereby licensed as a Licensed Professional Counselor"
 - b. Board Chair signature: P. Chip Coffey.
 - c. Issue date: 07/01/19.
 - d. Expiration date: 05/31/24
- 8. Board staff found that the license number Respondent used belongs to an active licensee.
- 9. In a conversation with the Board's Executive Director, it was disclosed by Director that School was applying for a grant, but it was denied due to Respondent's license not being able to be verified.
 - 10. Following the discovery, Respondent was terminated from his position at School.

VIOLATION

1. The services Respondent provided to students at School constitute the unauthorized practice of behavioral health as defined at A.R.S. § 32-3286(A).

ORDER

1. Under authority set forth in A.R.S. § 32-3284(A), the Board orders Respondent to immediately Cease and Desist from providing behavioral health services as defined in A.R.S. § 32-3251 et seq. until such time he is licensed to do so.

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RIGHT TO PETITION FOR REHEARING OR REVIEW

1	RIGHT TO PETITION FOR REHEARING OR REVIEW
2	Pursuant to A.R.S. § 41-1092.03 and § 32-3284(A), Respondent has the right to
3	obtain an administrative hearing in this matter by submitting a written request to the Board. The
4	Board must receive the request at its office within thirty (30) days after service of this Order.
5	A.R.S. § 41-1092.03(B). Service of this order is effective five (5) days after date of mailing. The
6	request must contain a concise statement of the reasons for the hearing. If Respondent requests a
7	hearing, pursuant to A.R.S. § 41-1092.06, Respondent has the additional right to request that the
8	Board conduct an informal settlement conference. To request an informal settlement conference,
9	Respondent must submit a written request to the Board no later than 20 days before the hearing
10 11	that may be scheduled in this matter. If a motion for rehearing is not filed, the Board's Order
12	becomes effective thirty-five (35) days after it is mailed to Respondent.
13	Respondent is further notified that the filing of a motion for rehearing is required to
14	preserve any rights of appeal to the Superior Court.
